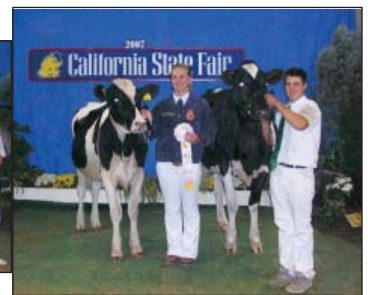
California State Fair Results
