Local Rules

1. The Western Dairy Classic is open to junior exhibitors 5 years of age by January 1, 2012 and not yet 21 by the same date, thus an exhibitor must have been born during the years 1991 through 2006.
2. In Registered divisions, the owner on the registration certificate must match the exhibitor on the entry form.
3. All Holsteins need to be at least 87% Registered Holstein Ancestry and be registered with Holstein Association USA to be shown in the Registered Holstein Division.
4. All Jerseys must be registered with the American Jersey Cattle Association to be shown in the Registered Jersey Division. No Original Animal (OA) or Progressive Register (PR) certificates will be allowed to show in the Registered Jersey Division.
5. Management reserves the final and absolute right to interpret the rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle questions and differences pertaining to the Western Dairy Classic Show.
6. There is no admission or parking fee for the Western Dairy Classic Show.
7. All Exhibitors will be released at the conclusion of their respective shows.
8. Exhibitors are expected to allow the use of their animals for the Judging Contest if so asked. Every effort will be made to use animals entered by willing participants.
9. The show uniform shall consist of a Shirt/Blouse with collar (no tank tops or t-shirts) and white pants. 4-H and FFA uniforms are acceptable but not required.
