

# 30,000 Pound Cow Award Application



Open to all members of the California Junior Holstein Association

## Rules:

1. Animal must be owned by the junior member prior to the animal's first calving. The animal must make her entire 30,000 lb. record under the ownership of the junior making the application.
2. The record must be made in 305 days or less and must be completed by December 31, 2025.
3. **An animal will qualify only once for this award.**
4. All entries must be accompanied by a copy of the DHIA Cow Page or a copy of the official DHIA Herd Test Sheet which lists the cow's current record, or an official pedigree.
5. All entries must be accompanied by a copy of the official registration paper, showing at least 87% Registered Holstein ancestry.
6. Applicant must be a California Junior Holstein Association Member.

## Rules:

Open to all members of the California Junior Holstein Association

The Junior Breeder of an Excellent Award is a program designed to recognize California Junior members who have, through the course of the project work, bred a Holstein cow who has been officially type classified EXCELLENT. In order to qualify for the award, the Junior must be listed as the breeder of the animal in question. Partnership animals will only be accepted if the partners were junior members at the time the animal was bred. Partnerships which include adult members will not be considered for this award. In order to qualify for this award, the cow on the entry blank must have been classified EXCELLENT before December 30, 2025.

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# LIFETIME PRODUCTION AWARD APPLICATION



## Rules:

Open to all members of the California Junior Holstein Association

1. Animal must be owned by the junior member prior to the animal's first calving. The animal must make her entire record under the ownership of the junior making the application.
2. Entry must be on some sort of official testing.
3. **An animal will qualify only once for each category.**
4. Production must be made prior to December 31, 2025 to qualify for this year. Record can be in progress so long as lifetime credits are reached by December 31, 2025.
5. Awards are for official lifetime production at the following levels of milk:  
150,000 lbs. 200,000 lbs.
6. **A recent Certificate of Lifetime Production and a photocopy of the registration paper must accompany entry.**

# JUNIOR PROGRESSIVE BREEDER AWARD APPLICATION



Open to all members of the California Junior Holstein Association who have bred Registered Holsteins that meet the criteria outlined in this application. Applicants must have their project animal(s) enrolled in official DHI or DHIR tests, as well as the Classification Program.

Gold stars will be awarded each year at the State Holstein Convention. Juniors qualifying on a single cow will receive one star, on two cows, two stars, etc. Junior members may accumulate their stars over the period of their Junior membership. When a Junior has accumulated 5 stars, they will automatically be designated a California Junior Progressive Breeder.

## Minimum Standards:

1. The cow must be bred by the Junior member making application. The breeder of the cow will be determined as stated on the registration certificate. The cow does not have to be presently owned by the Junior member making application. Applicant must have owned the dam of the cow entered at the time of conception. The cow must have a minimum of 87% Registered Holstein Ancestry to be eligible.
2. Only the latest 305 day, or less, production record and current classification score will be accepted.
3. All entries must be accompanied by a copy of the official DHIA Cow Page or a copy of the official DHIA Herd Test Sheet which lists the cow's current record, or a copy of an official pedigree.
4. The cow must have been officially classified in a Holstein Association USA Classification Program.
5. A cow may qualify his/her breeder for a Star Breeder recognition on only one occasion.
6. A cow must have milk production records and classification scores equal to or in excess of the age schedule below:

| AGE             | MILK        | CLASSIFICATION |
|-----------------|-------------|----------------|
| 2 Yr Old        | 25,000 lbs. | 85 points      |
| 3 Yr Old        | 26,000 lbs. | 86 points      |
| 4 Yr Old        | 27,000 lbs. | 87 points      |
| 5 Yr Old        | 28,000 lbs. | 88 points      |
| 6 Yr Old & Over | 30,000 lbs. | 90 points      |

7. For the 2025 awards, cows completing lactations after January 1, 2025 will be accepted as eligible entries. Deceased animals meeting this criteria are also eligible.
